Modification

SES AMERICOM, Inc. (SES AMERICOM) has filed an application for modification of its license for the AMC-6 fixed-satellite space station. Specifically, SES AMERICOM requests reassignment of AMC-6 from the 72° W.L. orbital location to the 101° W.L. orbital location upon the successful launch and entry into operation at 72° W.L. of the AMC-9 spacecraft. The 101° W.L. orbital location is already assigned to SES AMERICOM and is currently occupied by the AMC-4 spacecraft. SES AMERICOM will seek Commission authority to relocate AMC-4 in a subsequent filing.
