STREAMLINED INTERNATIONAL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FOR FILING

SECTION 214 APPLICATIONS (47 C.F.R. § 63.18); CABLE LANDING LICENSE APPLICATIONS (47 C.F.R. § 1.767) REQUESTS TO AUTHORIZE SWITCHED SERVICES OVER PRIVATE LINES (47 C.F.R. § 63.16); SECTION 310(B)(4) REQUESTS

Unless otherwise specified, the following procedures apply to the applications listed below:

The international Section 214 applications listed below have been found, upon initial review, to be acceptable for filing and subject to the streamlined processing procedures set forth in Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. These applications are for authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214, (a) to transfer control of an authorized carrier or to assign a carrier's existing authorization; and/or (b) to become a facilities-based international common carrier; and/or (c) to become a resale-based international common carrier.

Pursuant to Section 63.12 of the rules, these Section 214 applications will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice (see 47 C.F.R. § 1.4 regarding computation of time), and the applicant may commence operations on the 15th day, unless the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days after the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

Communications between outside parties and Commission staff concerning these applications are permitted subject to the Commission's rules for "permit-but-disclose proceedings." See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206. An application can be removed from streamlined processing only in the sound discretion of Commission staff. The filing of comments or a petition to deny will not necessarily result in an application being deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

The petitions for declaratory ruling listed below are (1) for authority under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4), to exceed the 25 percent foreign ownership benchmark applicable to common carrier radio licensees, or (2) under Section 63.16 of the rules, to add a foreign market to the list of markets for which carriers may provide switched services over private lines. The requested rulings will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice, effective the next day, unless the application is formally opposed or the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days of the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing. For this purpose, a formal opposition shall be sufficient only if it is received by the Commission and by the applicant within 14 days of the date of this public notice and its caption and text make it unmistakably clear that it is intended to be a formal opposition.

Pursuant to section 63.10 of the Commission's rules, Applicant requests non-dominant regulatory treatment for all U.S. international routes.

This application includes traffic originating in the states of Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Nebraska, North Dakota, Montana, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, Arizona, Minnesota, New Mexico, Oregon, and South Dakota, which are the "in-region" states of Qwest Communications. The applicant, Qwest Communications Corporation (QCC), is an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Qwest Communications.

On December 23, 2002, the Commission approved Qwest Communications' section 271 application to provide in-region, interLATA services originating in Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Nebraska, North Dakota, Montana, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming. See Application By Qwest Communications International Inc. for Authorization to Provide In-Region, InterLATA Services in Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Nebraska, North Dakota, Montana, Utah, Washington and Wyoming, WC Docket No. 02-314, Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 02-332, rel. December 23, 2002. Grant of QCC's international section 214 application would authorize it to provide international facilities-based and resale services originating in all "out-of-region" states and in these "in-region" states. QCC acknowledges, however, that grant of its request for authority to provide international services from Arizona, Minnesota, New Mexico, Oregon and South Dakota would be conditioned such that it would be effective for each of these five states only at such time as Qwest Communications receives section 271 authority for each such state.
