ERRATUM

Released: July 18, 2003

By the Chief, Satellite Division, International Bureau:

1. On July 11, 2003, the Commission released an Order adding Spacecom Satellite Communications Services S.C.C. Ltd.'s (Spacecom's) AMOS-2 satellite, licensed by Israel and to be located at 4° W.L., to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List (Permitted List), with certain conditions.¹ The first footnote of the Order is corrected to read as follows:

¹ The conventional Ku-band refers to frequencies in the 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.

2. This erratum was adopted prior to publication of DA 03-2274 and shall be effective upon release.
