## TRAINING ON FCC ELECTRONIC FILING/LICENSING SYSTEMS TO BE CONDUCTED TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2003, IN WASHINGTON, DC.

Training will cover ECFS, EDOCS, ULS, CDBS and IBFS.

The Federal Communications Commission will offer training sessions on several of the FCC's electronic licensing and/or filing systems at its Washington, DC, headquarters on Tuesday, November 18, 2003. The training begins at 9:00 am in the Commission Meeting Room TW-C305, 445 Twelfth Street, SW.
