Modification

SES Americom, Inc. has filed an application for modification of its authorization to operate the SATCOM C-4 satellite. SATCOM C-4 is a GSO C-band satellite currently operating at 135° W.L. The satellite is being replaced early at that orbital location by AMC-10, which was launched on February 5, 2004. SES Americom requests authority to relocate Satcom C-4 to 85° W.L. following the launch of AMC-16 and relocation of AMC-9 to 83° W.L. In addition, SES AMERICOM requests a waiver of Section 25.114(d)(3), which specifies the requirements for contour maps to be submitted with space station applications.
