Launch and Operating Authority

EchoStar Satellite L.L.C. has filed an application to construct, launch and operate a geostationary satellite in the fixed satellite service at 113° W.L. operating in the 18.3-18.8 and 19.7-20.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 28.35-28.6 and 29.25-20.0 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. EchoStar proposes to offer Direct-to-Home services, two-way broadband services, interactive services and HD content on a non-common carrier basis. In addition, EchoStar has requested a limited waiver of the Commission's rules, to the extent necessary, to permit it to submit information relating to specific TT&C frequencies and satellite spacecraft design at a future date, stating the information will be submitted when it becomes available.
