Seventh Floor Washington, D.C. 20005	05/27/2004	In the Matter of the Commission's Rules with regards to the prevention of further deterioration to the New Jersey FM band broadcast environment, the petition proposes 1) amend the rules to require FM translator and LPFM stations requesting to operate in New Jersey to provide protection to the 44 dBu (50,50) contour as the protected contour for full power, commercial FM broadcast facilities licensed to New Jersey communities; 2) adopt use of the 20 dB desired to undesired ("D/U") ratio for the second adjacent channel; 3) prohibit the grant of future licenses to translator stations in New Jersey with effective radiated power of less than 100 watts; and 4) prohibit the grant of LPFM licenses to any community in New Jersey.
