STREAMLINED INTERNATIONAL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FOR FILING

SECTION 214 APPLICATIONS (47 C.F.R. § 63.18); CABLE LANDING LICENSE APPLICATIONS (47 C.F.R. § 1.767) REQUESTS TO AUTHORIZE SWITCHED SERVICES OVER PRIVATE LINES (47 C.F.R. § 63.16); SECTION 310(B)(4) REQUESTS

Unless otherwise specified, the following procedures apply to the applications listed below:

The international Section 214 applications listed below have been found, upon initial review, to be acceptable for filing and subject to the streamlined processing procedures set forth in Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. These applications are for authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214, (a) to transfer control of an authorized carrier or to assign a carrier's existing authorization; and/or (b) to become a facilities-based international common carrier; and/or (c) to become a resale-based international common carrier.

Pursuant to Section 63.12 of the rules, these Section 214 applications will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice (see 47 C.F.R. § 1.4 regarding computation of time), and the applicant may commence operations on the 15th day, unless the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days after the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

Communications between outside parties and Commission staff concerning these applications are permitted subject to the Commission's rules for "permit-but-disclose proceedings." See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206. An application can be removed from streamlined processing only in the sound discretion of Commission staff. The filing of comments or a petition to deny will not necessarily result in an application being deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

The petitions for declaratory ruling listed below are (1) for authority under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4), to exceed the 25 percent foreign ownership benchmark applicable to common carrier radio licensees, or (2) under Section 63.16 of the rules, to add a foreign market to the list of markets for which carriers may provide switched services over private lines. The requested rulings will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice, effective the next day, unless the application is formally opposed or the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days of the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing. For this purpose, a formal opposition shall be sufficient only if it is received by the Commission and by the applicant within 14 days of the date of this public notice and its caption and text make it unmistakably clear that it is intended to be a formal opposition.

Application for consent to: (1) assign certain assets of Comcast Phone of Ohio, LLC ("Comcast Ohio"), related to its provision of telephone service in Columbus, Ohio, from Comcast Ohio to Insight Phone of Ohio, LLC ("Insight Ohio"). Insight Ohio is indirectly wholly-owned by Insight Midwest Holdings, LLC ("Insight Midwest Holdings"); and (2) transfer control of AT&T Broadband Phone of Indiana, LLC (Comcast Indiana) and AT&T Broadband Phone of Kentucky, LLC (Comcast Kentucky) from Comcast Phone, LLC (Comcast Phone) to Insight Midwest Holdings. Under the proposed transaction, all of the limited liability interests in Comcast Indiana and Comcast Kentucky will be acquired indirectly by Insight Midwest Holdings. Insight Midwest Holdings is an indirect 50% owned and controlled subsidiary of Insight Communications Company, Inc.

Comcast Ohio, Comcast Indiana and Comcast Kentucky are currently wholly-owned by Comcast Phone and are authorized to provide international telecommunications service under its international section 214 authorizations, File Nos. ITC-214-19970801-00449 (old File No. ITC-97-441), ITC-T/C-20020228-00138. Comcast Phone will retain and continue to provide service under its international section 214 authorizations. Grant of the captioned application shall constitute Commission authorization of the proposed assignment and transfers of control. Unless otherwise specified in the grant, Insight Ohio, Comcast Kentucky and Comcast Indiana will be authorized to provide the same services on the same routes as permitted under Comcast Phone's section 214 authorizations cited above, and Insight Ohio, Comcast Kentucky and Comcast Indiana may provide such service to any customers they may obtain in the ordinary course of business.
