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**FCC AND SAMSON TECHNOLOGIES ENTER INTO \$26,500 CONSENT  
DECREE CONCERNING EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS**

Washington, D.C. – The Federal Communications Commission today entered into a Consent Decree with Samson Technologies, Inc. (“Samson”) that resolves possible violations of 47 U.S.C. § 302a(b) and 47 C.F.R. § 2.803(a) concerning Samson’s importation and marketing of certain models of multi-track music recording devices.

As part of the Consent Decree, Samson will make a \$26,500 voluntary payment to the U.S. Treasury and will implement a Compliance Plan aimed at preventing future violations of the Commission’s equipment regulations.
