On December 8, 2004, PanAmSat Licensee Corp. ("PanAmSat") requested special temporary authority ("STA") for 30 days, commencing on December 24, 2004, to relocate Galaxy 12 from 125.25° W.L. to 125.05° W.L. and to operate the satellite at that orbital location. Pursuant to Section 25.120 of the Commission's rules,1 PanAmSat hereby requests an STA to continue operating Galaxy 12 at 125.05° W.L. for an additional 180 days following the expiration of the 30-day STA that PanAmSat previously requested.
