Modification

SES Americom, Inc. filed an application for modification of its authorization, pursuant to the streamlined fleet management procedures under section 25.118(e) of the Commission's rules, to relocate its AMC-2 satellite from the 105° W.L. orbit location to the 85° W.L. orbit location.

SES Americom currently operates the AMC-2 C/Ku-band hybrid satellite at 105° W.L. pursuant to conditional authority granted by the Commission in 2003, and is authorized to operate in the Ku-band and use the C-band for TT&C at that location. (See File No. SAT-STA-20030820-00158.) Prior to 2003, AMC-2 (previously known as "GE-2") operated at 85° W.L., its original assigned orbital location, in both the C- and Ku-bands. (See File No. SAT-MOD-20021108-00205.) SES Americom now proposes to return AMC-2 to 85° W.L. for C- and Ku-band operations.
