## **FCC AND NARUC ANNOUNCE MEMBERS OF JOINT FEDERAL/STATE VOIP ENHANCED 911 ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE**

Washington, D.C.: The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) today announced the names of the ten-member joint Federal/State Task Force created July 25, 2005 to facilitate compliance with and enforcement of the Commission's VoIP E911 rules.

Scheduled to begin meeting this month, the members -- whose names are listed below -- will discuss topics such as developing educational materials to educate consumers about their rights and the requirements of the FCC's VoIP E911 order and rules, how best to ensure compliance and facilitate enforcement, where necessary, and data collection and sharing of best practices. In addition, the Task Force will actively seek input from representatives of the National Emergency Number Association (NENA), the Association of Public Safety Communications Officials (APCO), and state and local 911 authorities. Through coordination with these associations and authorities, the Task Force seeks to facilitate compliance with the Commission's VoIP 911 rules.
