Modification

SES Americom, Inc. (SES Americom) has filed an application for modification of its license for its in-orbit fixed-satellite service hybrid C-/Ku-band satellite, AMC-6, authorized at the 72° W.L. orbital position to operate in the extended Ku-band. AMC-6 is currently authorized to operate in the C-band, 5.925 - 6.425 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 3.7 - 4.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) and in the Ku-band, 14.0 - 14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.7 - 12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth). In response to customer demand, SES Americom plans to provide service to South America in the standard and extended Ku-bands and will modify its coverage areas accordingly. Specifically, SES Americom seeks to add the extended Ku-band, 13.75 - 14.0 GHz and 11.45 - 11.7 GHz, to the authorization for its AMC-6 satellite.
