Modification

Star One S.A. requests that the grant of authority to add the Star One C2 satellite at 70° W.L. to the Permitted Space Station List be modified to reflect the updated technical specifications of the to-be-built satellite. Star One will no longer require authority to provide service to the United States using the C-band frequencies on this satellite and is relinquishing that authority. In addition, Star One proposes changes in TT&C frequencies: from 6423.6 and 6424.4 MHz to 6424.5 MHz (one only) and from 4199.0 and 4199.8 MHz to 4199.0 and 4199.9 MHz; and Ku-band beacon signals: from 11701.0 and 12199.0 MHz to 11700.5 and 12199.3 MHz.
