**STREAMLINED INTERNATIONAL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FOR FILING  
SECTION 214 APPLICATIONS (47 C.F.R. § 63.18); SECTION 310(B)(4) REQUESTS**

Unless otherwise specified, the following procedures apply to the applications listed below:

The international Section 214 applications listed below have been found, upon initial review, to be acceptable for filing and subject to the streamlined processing procedures set forth in Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. These applications are for authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214, (a) to transfer control of an authorized carrier or to assign a carrier's existing authorization; and/or (b) to become a facilities-based international common carrier; and/or (c) to become a resale-based international common carrier.

Pursuant to Section 63.12 of the rules, these Section 214 applications will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice (see 47 C.F.R. § 1.4 regarding computation of time), and the applicant may commence operations on the 15th day, unless the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days after the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

Communications between outside parties and Commission staff concerning these applications are permitted subject to the Commission's rules for "permit-but-disclose proceedings." See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206. An application can be removed from streamlined processing only in the sound discretion of Commission staff. The filing of comments or a petition to deny will not necessarily result in an application being deemed ineligible for streamlined processing.

The petitions for declaratory ruling listed below are for authority under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b)(4), to exceed the 25 percent foreign ownership benchmark applicable to common carrier radio licensees. The requested rulings will be granted 14 days after the date of this public notice, effective the next day, unless the application is formally opposed or the Commission has informed the applicant in writing, within 14 days of the date of this public notice, that the application, on further examination, has been deemed ineligible for streamlined processing. For this purpose, a formal opposition shall be sufficient only if it is received by the Commission and by the applicant within 14 days of the date of this public notice and its caption and text make it unmistakably clear that it is intended to be a formal opposition.

Application for consent to assign substantially all of the assets associated with the provision of international telecommunications service to customers in Minnesota, including certain customer accounts, from Seren Innovations, Inc. (Seren) to Charter Fiberlink, LLC (Charter), a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Charter Communications Holding Company, LLC (Charter Holding). Charter Holding is owned directly by Charter Communications Inc. (42.75 percent equity) and indirectly by P.G. Allen (57.25 percent equity). Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement, CCVIII Operating, LLC, which is under 100% ultimate common ownership and control with Charter, will acquire from Seren substantially all of the assets associated with Seren's provision of local and long distance telecommunications service, cable television service, and high speed data service to customers in Minnesota. Immediately following the acquisition, CCVIII Operating, LLC will transfer to Charter certain contracts and other intangible assets, and will enter into necessary arrangements with Charter, to enable Charter to provide local and long distance service to customers previously served by Seren and to other new customers. After the acquisition, Charter Fiberlink will retain its international Section 214 authorization, File No. ITC-214-20030127-00071, and Seren will retain its international section 214 authorization, ITC-214-19990310-00139.
