Modification

PanAmSat Licensee Corp., filed a modification application request for authority to relocate its Galaxy 9 spacecraft from 90.9° W.L. orbital location where it is currently serving as an in-orbit spare to 74.15° W.L orbital location. At the 74.15° W.L orbital location Galaxy 9 will operate using the Conventional C-band frequencies 5925-6425 MHz and 3700-4200 MHz bands.
