COMMISSIONER DEBORAH TAYLOR TATE APPLAUDS THE LAUNCH OF THE NEW PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU

I applaud the Commission's demonstrated dedication to public safety and homeland security. The tragedies of September 11, 2001 and Hurricanes Katrina and Rita remind us of the importance of reliable, interoperable communications systems. Earlier this year, at the second meeting of the FCC Independent Panel Reviewing the Impact of Hurricane Katrina on Communications Networks in Mississippi, I heard personal accounts of the devastation caused by Hurricane Katrina.
