Petition for Declaratory Ruling to be Added to the Permitted List

SES Satellites (Gibraltar) LTD. (SES) has filed a Petition for Declaratory ruling to add the AMC-18 satellite at 104.95° W.L. to the Permitted Space Station List to replace the Satcom C-4 satellite that is presently at that orbital location. SES seeks to provide C-band service in the United States using the 5925-6425 and 3700-4200 MHz frequencies. SES has been licensed by Gibraltar to operate the AMC-18 satellite at the 104.95° W.L. orbit location. SES will provide Fixed-Satellite Service, except for direct-to-home (DTH) services, from the AMC-18 satellite using the C-band frequencies to the United States.
