(XM) requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to operate one lower power terrestrial repeater (less than 2 kW EIRP) at weekly PGA Tour events occurring at various locations from January 1, 2007, through July 1, 2007, that are listed in Exhibit A to the application and pursuant to the technical parameters specified in this request. Special Temporary Authority

On December 11, 2006, XM Radio Inc. (XM) requested special temporary authority (STA), for a period of 180 days, to operate repeaters with power levels of up to 0.5 watts equivalent isotropically radiated power (EIRP) and 0.0001 watts EIRP at trade shows in various cities as set forth in Exhibit A to the request. XM states the repeaters are necessary to provide quality reception inside trade show venues, due to signal blockage from walls and ceilings. This proceeding has been designated as "permit-but-disclose" under the Commission's rules governing ex parte communications.
