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FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION RELEASES STUDY ON TELEPHONE TRENDS

Washington D.C. – Today, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) released its *Trends in Telephone Service* report, which summarizes in one convenient reference source information published in various reports over the course of the past year.
