Globalstar Licensee LLC requests authority for 180 days to increase the number of operational satellites in the Globalstar Big LEO constellation from 40 to 48 and increase the number of in-orbit spares from 3 to 4. Globalstar also proposes to modify the spacing between satellites within each orbital plane and adjust the relative phasing between satellites in adjacent planes to reconfigure the constellation from a single Walker array to a 16-satellite Walker array and a 32-satellite Walker array.
