On September 28, 2007, Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. (Sirius) requested special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to operate fifteen new satellite digital audio radio service (SDARS) terrestrial repeaters at power levels at or below two kilowatts equivalent isotropically radiated power (EIRP) (average) in the following cities: Atlanta, GA; Chicago, IL; Dallas, TX; Houston, TX; New York, NY; St. Louis, MO; Tampa, FL; and Orlando, FL. Sirius states that these additional repeaters are necessary for the provision of high-quality commercial SDARS programming nationwide.
