Orbcomm proposes to use the requested links for initial deployment and testing operations connected with the launch of seven proposed new satellites, and for emergency restoration capability.

Modification

New ICO Satellite Services, G.P. (New ICO) requests authority to modify its reservation of spectrum to provide mobile satellite service (MSS) in the 2 GHz band. New ICO proposes the following changes to the physical and technical characteristics of its ICO-G1 satellite at the 92.85° W.L. orbital location: 1) changes to the forward (Ka-to S-band) and return (S-to Ka-band) band plan, including telemetry, tracking, and control (TT&C) center frequencies; 2) the addition of Ka-to-Ka-band connectivity to calibrate the ground based beam forming subsystem; 3) an increase in the aggregate S Band downlink equivalent isotropic radiated power (e.i.r.p.) capability; 4) an increase in the Ka-band downlink e.i.r.p. capability; and 5) other minor changes to the electrical and physical characteristics of the ICO-G1 satellite consistent with the manufacturing contract and incorporated in the satellite. New ICO also seeks a waiver of several Commission rules: 47 C.F.R. § 25.210(i) (cross-polarization isolation); 47 C.F.R. § 25.114(d)(3) (antenna gain contours) and 47 C.F.R. § 25.202(g)(in-band TT&C).

Petition for Declaratory Ruling to be Added to the Permitted List

On November 27, 2007, Telesat Brasil Capacidade de Satélites Ltda. (formerly known as Loral Skynet do Brasil Ltda.) filed a notification of change of ownership of satellite on the Permitted Space Station List. Telesat Brasil Capacidade de Satélites Ltda. is licensed by Brazil to operate the Estrela do Sul 1 space station. Telesat Brasil Capacidade de Satélites Ltda. notifies the Commission that its indirect ownership and control has been transferred to Telesat Holdings Inc. The Estrela do Sul 1 satellite, located at the 63° W.L. orbital location, was added to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List on December 23, 2003. Petition for Declaratory Ruling to be Added to the Permitted List

On November 27, 2007, Telesat Canada filed a notification of change of ownership of satellites on the Permitted Space Station List. Telesat Canada is licensed by Canada to operate the ANIK F1, ANIK F1-R, ANIK F2, and ANIK F3 space stations. Telesat Canada notifies the Commission of the transfer of ownership and control of Telesat Canada to Telesat Holdings Inc.

The ANIK F1 satellite, located at the 107.3° W.L. orbital location, was added to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List on December 19, 2000. Telesat Canada Petition for Declaratory Ruling for Inclusion of ANIK F1 on the Permitted Space Station List, Order, DA 00-2835, 15 FCC Rcd 24828 (Int'l Bur. Sat. and Rad. Div. 2000) (granting File No. SAT-PDR-20000420-00083, Call Sign S2745).

The ANIK F1-R satellite, located at the 107.3° W.L. orbital location, was added to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List on July 21, 2005. The ANIK F2 satellite, located at the 111.1° W.L. orbital location, was added to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List on December 18, 2002. Telesat Canada Petition for Declaratory Ruling for Inclusion of ANIK F2 on the Permitted Space Station List, Order, DA 02-3490, 17 FCC Rcd 25287 (Int'l Bur. 2002) (granting File No. SAT-PDR-20010906-00082, Call Sign S2472).

The ANIK F3 satellite, located at the 118.7° W.L. orbital location, was added to the Commission's Permitted Space Station List on January 19, 2007.
