Special Temporary Authority

On December 13, 2007, Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. filed a request for special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to operate 15 new satellite digital audio radio service (SDARS) terrestrial repeaters at power levels at or below 2 kW equivalent isotropically radiated power (EIRP) (average) in the following cities: Baltimore, MD, Chicago, IL, Cincinnati, OH, Miami, FL, New York, NY, Bogota, NJ, Wayne, NJ, Philadelphia, PA, Sacramento, CA, and Washington, D.C. Sirius states that it has identified these sites as necessary to the provision of its commercial SDARS.

Special Temporary Authority

On December 19, 2007, XM Radio Inc. (XM) filed a request for special temporary authority to operate a very low power repeater (not exceeding 0.5 watts EIRP) at its office building in Vienna, Virginia for 180 days.
