Modification

Intelsat North America LLC has filed an application for modification of the license for the Intelsat 602 satellite. The application seeks authority to operate Intelsat 602 at the 177.85° E.L. orbital location in an inclined orbit in the 5850-6425 MHz, 14-14.5 GHz, 3625 - 4200 MHz, 10.950-11.200 GHz, and 11.450-11.700 GHz frequency bands. Intelsat also requests that the Part 25 waivers originally granted for the Intelsat 602 in 2000 continue to apply at the 177.85° E.L. orbital location. See Applications of Intelsat LLC for Authority to Operate, and to Further Construct, Launch, and Operate C-band and Ku-band Satellites that Form a Global Communications System in Geostationary Orbit, Memorandum Opinion Order and Authorization, 15 FCC Rcd 15460, 15529 (2000).
