Launch and Operating Authority

On February 17, 2009, XM Radio Inc. filed a request for authority to launch and operate a new Satellite Digital Audio Radio Service (SDARS) space station, designated as XM-5, at the 85.2° W.L. orbital location for use as an in-orbit spare for both the Sirius Radio Inc. (2320-2332.5 MHz) and XM Radio Inc. (2332.5-2345 MHz) SDARS systems. The XM-5 satellite will receive feeder link transmissions in the 7050.5-7072.5 MHz band.
