**ERRATUM**

By the Deputy Chief, Broadband Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:

On June 16, 2009, the Broadband Division of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau released a *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, DA 09-1340, in the above-captioned proceeding. This Erratum corrects the *Memorandum Opinion and Order* as follows:

1. In Paragraph 27, the first sentence has been revised to read as follows:

“In this case, we conclude that the Commission’s general policy should apply and that the licensees whose licenses expired before January 10, 2005 should not be allowed to “split-the-football” with active, co-channel EBS licensees.”
