Launch and Operating Authority

Intelsat North America LLC (Intelsat) seeks authority to launch and operate a Ku-band satellite, to be known as Intelsat 15, at the 85.15 E.L. orbital location. Intelsat seeks authority to operate the Intelsat 15 satellite in the following frequency bands: 10950-11200 MHz (space-to-Earth), 11450-11700 MHz (space-to-Earth), 12500-12750 MHz (space-to-Earth), 13750-14000 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 14000-14500 MHz (Earth-to-space). Intelsat requests waivers, to the extent necessary, of Sections 25.202(g) and 25.114(d)(3) of the Commission's rules. Intelsat also requests a determination that it has met the first three implementation milestones in Section 25.164 of the Commission's rules (execute a binding contract for construction, complete the critical design review, and commence construction) and that, in the event a bond is imposed, the Commission reduce the bond amount from \$3,000,000 to \$750,000.
