Pursuant to Section 25.210(l) of the Commission's Rules, Pegasus Development DBS Corporation ("Pegasus"), by its attorneys, hereby files this annual report regarding the status of its satellite construction. In December 2008, Pegasus was awarded a license to deploy a 17/24 GHz satellite system at the 115°W orbital location. See Stamp Grant, File Nos. SAT-LOA-20060412-00044; SAT-AMD-20080114-00023 (granted December 17, 2008). In January 2009, Pegasus posted the required bond for the satellite system. See Public Notice, Report No. SAT-00576, DA No. 09-173 (January 30, 2009). Pegasus is working to meet its next milestone in December 2009. Pegasus has no other applicable information to report under any of the specific categories listed in Section 25.210(l).
