EchoStar Satellite Operating L.L.C. requests authority to launch and operate a Direct Broadcasting Satellite (DBS) service space station, EchoStar-14, at the 118.9° W.L. orbital location, using the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
