## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: September 14, 2009

By the District Director, Seattle Office, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

- 1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules<sup>1</sup> to Jason Daub, licensee of a Citizens Band ("CB") Radio Service station in Seattle, Washington.
- 2. On August 17, 2009, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau's Seattle Office inspected Daub's CB radio station located in Seattle, Washington, and found the following violation:
  - a. 47 C.F.R. § 95.411 (CB Rule 11): "May I use power amplifiers? (a) You may not attach the following items (power amplifiers) to your certificated CB transmitter in any way: (1) External radio frequency (RF) power amplifiers (sometimes called linears or linear amplifiers); ..." At the time of the inspection, an agent from this office determined that Daub's CB station had a Magnum 2500 linear amplifier connected in-line with his certificated CB transmitter.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>2</sup> and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Jason Daub must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by Jason Daub. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

- 4. This Notice shall be sent by Certified Mail/Return Receipt Requested and regular mail to Jason Daub, at his address of record.
- 5. The Privacy Act of 1974<sup>3</sup> requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.<sup>4</sup>
