NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: September 14, 2009

By the District Director, Seattle Office, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

- 1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, to Comcast of Washington IV, Inc., ("Comcast"), operator of a cable system in Hoquiam, Washington.
- 2. On August 11, 2009, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau's Seattle Office inspected the Comcast cable system located at Aberdeen and Hoquiam, Washington, and observed the following violation:
 - a. 47 C.F.R. § 76.605(a)(12): "As an exception to the general provision requiring measurements to be made at subscriber terminals, and without regard to the type of signals carried by the cable television system, signal leakage from a cable television system shall be measured in accordance with the procedures outlined in § 76.609(h) and shall be limited as follows: Over 54 MHz up to and including 216 MHz 20 micro-volts per meter, measured at 3 meters." At the time of the inspection, an agent observed signal leakage on the frequency of 121.2625 MHz at the following location:
 - 1) In alley back of 2711 Sumner Avenue, Hoquiam, WA 51 μ V/m
- 3. Pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Comcast must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in

- 4. This Notice shall be sent to by Certified Mail/Return Receipt Requested and regular mail to Comcast of Washington IV, Inc., at its address of record.

Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
