NOTICE OF VIOLATION

By the District Director, Seattle Office, Western Region, Enforcement Bureau:

- 1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules¹ to KCTS Television, registrant of antenna structure # 1032916 in Seattle, Washington.
- 2. On August 14, 2009, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau's Seattle Office inspected antenna structure # 1032916 located in Seattle, Washington, and observed the following violation:
 - a. 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(g): "...the Antenna Structure Registration Number must be displayed in a conspicuous place so that it is readily visible near the base of the antenna structure." At the time of the inspection, the agent observed no Antenna Structure Registration Number posted at the base of the tower, at the transmitter building entrance, or at the driveway entrance to the KCTS Television transmission facility.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, KCTS Television, must submit a written statement concerning this matter within twenty (20) days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of KCTS Television. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

- 4. This Notice shall be sent by Certified Mail/Return Receipt Requested and regular mail to KCTS Television, at its address of record.
- 5. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
