Special Temporary Authority

On September 23, 2009, Intelsat North America LLC filed a request for special temporary authority to continue operating the Intelsat 706 space station at the 54.85° E.L. orbital location for a period of 61 days, commencing on October 6, 2009 through December 5, 2009. Intelsat states that the proposed operations shall be in accordance with the ITU filings of the Indian Administration and the conditions imposed as part of prior authorizations for the Intelsat 706 to operate at this orbital location.
