Dear Congressman Frelinghuysen:

Thank you for your letter on behalf of Morris County, New Jersey, regarding the County's application for authority to operate a public safety paging facility on frequency 476.2875 MHz. Because the Commission has allocated this frequency for commercial use, the County submitted a waiver request with its application to enable it to use the frequency for public safety purposes.

I am pleased to inform you that the Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau released an *Order* on October 8, 2009, granting the applications and waiver request. In reaching this decision, the Bureau determined that grant of the waiver will provide the County with access to additional UHF spectrum in order to promote effective public safety communications without compromising radio operations of other licensees. I am enclosing a copy of that *Order* for your information.
