Special Temporary Authority

Sirius XM Radio Inc. (Sirius XM) requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to continue to operate 25 terrestrial repeaters with an average effective isotropically radiated power (EIRP) up to 2000 watts at specified locations throughout the United States. Sirius XM will operate these repeaters within the 2320-2345 MHz frequency band, which is assigned for Sirius XM's exclusive use to provide Satellite Digital Audio Radio Service (SDARS).
