Intelsat North America LLC requests special temporary authority, for a period of 180 days, to continue operating the Intelsat 706 space station in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth), 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space), 10.95-11.2 GHz (space-to-Earth), 11.45-11.7 GHz, (space-to-Earth), 12.50-12.75 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands at the 54.85° E.L. orbital location. Intelsat states that the proposed operations shall be in accordance with the ITU filings of the Indian Administration and the conditions imposed as part of prior authorizations for the Intelsat 706 to operate at this orbital location.
