Special Temporary Authority

PanAmSat Licensee Corp. requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days, beginning June 1, 2010, to conduct telemetry, tracking, and telecommand (TT&C) operations necessary drift its fixed-satellite service space station, Intelsat 3R, from 43.1 W.L. to 81.0 W.L. and to operate the satellite temporarily at 81.0 W.L. in accordance with the Argentine Administration's ITU filings in the C- and Ku-bands. PanAmSat seeks to operate Intelsat 3R in the following frequency bands: 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth), 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space), 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space).
