Dear Chairman Genachowski:

I am writing in support of the assignment of the operating license for WSTX-AM and WSTX-FM from Family Broadcasting, Inc. to Caledonia Communication Corporation and to inquire on the status of this application.

Attorney Kevin Rames, President of Caledonia Communication Corporation (CCC), has been managing WSTX-AM and WSTX-FM under a Time Brokerage Agreement since 2006. CCC has received the support of the St.Croix community, which has urged approval for the assignment of the license. It is my understanding that the only outstanding matter preventing approval of CCC's acquisition of the stations relates to the revocation of the license from Family Broadcasting based on the violations of FCC rules and regulations that were committed by Family Broadcasting many years ago. I am advised that, if the license is revoked, the stations will go dark for an extended period of time after over 50 years on continuous broadcast and it is possible that one or both of the stations may never return to the air.



WSTX has been broadcasting to the US Virgin Islands community for over fifty years. It is an important source that keeps our community informed, entertained and enlightened.
