FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION TECHNOLOGY SHOWCASE TO MARK 20^{TH} ANNIVERSARY OF AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT TO BE HELD AT DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

Washington, DC -- The FCC's Technology Showcase, previously scheduled for Monday, July 19 at the FCC Headquarters, will now be held on the same date, in the Main Foyer at the Department of Commerce, 1401 Constitution Ave., NW, Washington, DC. from 11 AM to 3 PM.
