Notice of Violation

Released: August 10, 2010

By the Resident Agent, Houston Office, South Central Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation (“Notice”) issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission’s Rules,¹ to Time Warner Entertainment (“Time Warner”), operator of a cable television system in Laredo, Texas.
2. On July 27, 2010, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau’s Houston Office inspected Time Warner’s cable television system located in Laredo, Texas and observed the following violation:

47 C.F.R. § 76.605(a)(12) of the Rules requires that cable operators maintain their cable system signal leakage below 20 microvolts per meter ($\mu\text{V}/\text{m}$) measured at 3 meters when operating in the frequency band between 54 MHz and 216 MHz. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 76.605(a)(12). The agent measured signal leakage in excess of 20 $\mu\text{V}/\text{m}$ on 133.2625 MHz at the following location:

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Time Warner must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude

recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action. The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of Time Warner. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to Time Warner Entertainment at its address of record.
5. The Privacy Act of 1974³ requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
