ATT20100507S.1	The DOT has initiated the South bound US1 Bridge Replacement project and the North bound US1 Bridge replacement project in Palm Beach County (City of Jupiter). AT&T has a 2100 pair copper cable on one of the bridges. AT&T will cut the facilities working on the copper to existing Digital Loop Carrier facilities. The copper cable will be removed before the bridge work starts. The fiber cable feeding the existing Digital Loop Carrier is not involved with the bridge replacements. Cutover from copper to Digital Loop Carrier will be required.	Jupiter, FL
