Dear Congressman Stupak:

Thank you for your recent letter on behalf of WMKT(AM), Charlevoix, Michigan, which is licensed to MacDonald Garber Broadcasting, Inc. ("MGBI"). MGBI is interested in relocating a FM translator station from Alpena, Michigan to East Jordan, Michigan. I appreciate the opportunity to respond.

A review of the Commission's records indicates that MGBI is not the current licensee of a FM translator station that is located in Alpena. The Commission also does not have a record of a pending application proposing to move a FM translator from Alpena to East Jordan. If MGBI wishes to move a FM translator station from Alpena to East Jordan in one "hop", it would be considered a "major change" application, and such applications are accepted only during designated filing windows. Any "major change" application submitted outside of a filing window must include a waiver request and supporting documentation that demonstrates good cause to grant the waiver.

The Media Bureau staff is available to discuss the Commission's regulations governing the relocation of FM translator stations. If MGBI has any additional questions regarding this matter, a representative may contact Mr. James Bradshaw at (202) 418-2739.
