Dear Congresswoman Eshoo:

Thank you for your letter requesting "information concerning the FCC's plans for ensuring the security of our nation's telecommunications networks." On receipt of your letter, I mobilized an intra-agency team of subject matter experts to examine in detail each of the questions in your letter. In addition, as appropriate, Commission officials consulted with their federal inter-agency peers and industry officials to gather additional information.

The staff has concluded its work and is prepared to provide to you and your staff a detailed response to each area about which you inquired. However, given the sensitive nature of the subject matter and the staff's findings, I respectfully suggest that Commission officials be permitted to present the findings to you and members of your staff via an in-person oral briefing.

I look forward to working with you and other members of Congress to ensure that our Nation's telecommunications networks remain reliable and secure for the benefit of the American public, business, and government.
