2012 NANP Fund Budget & Contribution Factor

Dear Ms. Gillett:

This is to advise the Federal Communications Commission that the North American Numbering Council ("NANC"), at its March 9, 2011 meeting, unanimously concurred with the recommendation of the Billing and Collection Working Group to approve the attached July 2011 – June 2012 North American Numbering Plan ("NANP") Fund Budget of \$5,857,267, including a \$750,000 contingency allowance. The US carriers will be required to contribute \$5,762,323 to the NANP Fund and the international participants (Canada and Caribbean countries) will be required to contribute the remaining \$94,944.

In addition, the NANC, at its March 9, 2011 meeting, unanimously concurred with the recommendation of the Billing and Collection Working Group to approve the July 2011 – June 2012 NANP Fund Contribution Factor at 0.0000220. This contribution factor is based on using the anticipated NANP Fund surplus of \$1,141,441, as of June 30, 2011, which reduces the required total contribution from US carriers to \$4,620,882.

Attached is a copy of the Billing and Collection Work Group's report on this matter. I have also attached the report on this matter to the NANC by Welch LLP, the billing and collection agent for the NANP Fund.
