NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: August 24, 2011

By the Resident Agent, Miami Office, South Central Region, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation (“Notice”) issued pursuant to section 1.89 of the Commission’s rules,¹ to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, registrant of antenna structure # 1041903 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

2. On August 19, 2011, an agent of the Enforcement Bureau’s Miami Office inspected antenna structure # 1041903 located at 2150 NW 26th Ave., Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311, and observed the following violation(s):

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(g): “The Antenna Structure Registration Number must be displayed in a conspicuous place so that it is readily visible near the base of the antenna structure. Material used to display the Antenna Structure Registration Number must be weather resistant and of sufficient size to be easily seen at the base of the antenna structure.” At the time of inspection, the Antenna Structure Registration Number was not posted at or near the base of the antenna structure.

3. Pursuant to section 403 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and section 1.89 of the Commission’s rules, Broward County Board of County Commissioners must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and

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preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the Broward County Board of County Commissioners. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, and regular mail to Broward County Board of County Commissioners at its address of record.

5. The Privacy Act of 1974³ requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
