Special Temporary Authority

EchoStar Corporation requests special temporary authority to continue to conduct telemetry, tracking, and control in the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands necessary to continue to operate the EchoStar 3 satellite at the 61.45° W.L. orbital location as an in-orbit spare satellite for a period of 180 days.
