SECOND ERRATUM

Released: April 16, 2012

By the Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau:

On November 18, 2011, the Commission released a *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (R&O and FNPRM)*, FCC 11-161, in the above-captioned proceeding. This Erratum amends the *R&O and FNPRM* as indicated below:

1. In paragraph 134, the last sentence, which includes the cost-estimation function, is corrected to read as follows.

That cost estimation function is defined as:

$$\begin{aligned} \ln(\text{total cost} + 1) = & 7.08224 + 0.02123 * \ln(\text{distance to nearest central office in feet} + 1) \\ & - 0.14857 * \ln(\text{number of households in wire center} + \text{businesses in wire center} + 1) \\ & + 0.2154 * \ln(\text{total road feet in wire center} + 1) \\ & + 0.05653 * (\ln(\text{number of households in wire center} + \text{businesses in wire center} + 1)) ^2 \\ & - 0.00668 * (\ln(\text{number of businesses in wire center} + 1)) ^2 \\ & - 0.07316 * \ln(\text{sum of, for all census blocks in wire center } ((\text{number of households in} \\ & \text{census block} + \text{businesses in census block}) / \text{square miles in census} \\ & \text{block}) + 1) \end{aligned}$$

2. In paragraph 135, in the first sentence, replace the words “will be converted into dollars and then further” with “, which is a monthly cost estimate, will be annualized and then ”.
