Thank you for your letter expressing concerns about enforcement of conditions that the Commission established in its *Comcast/NBCU Merger Order*. Your letter touches on a number of important issues, and it will be included in various proceeding records for Commission consideration.

I value your views and want to assure you that the Commission is committed to monitor and vigorously enforce Comcast's compliance with the conditions of the *Merger Order*. In fact, as you are aware, the Commission's Enforcement Bureau adopted a consent decree on June 27, 2012, resolving its investigation of Comcast's compliance with certain of the broadband-related merger conditions. As you noted in your recent press release, by extending a merger condition for an additional year, this consent decree will provide direct benefits to consumers.

Some allegations desire for efficient resolution of compliance complaints. The Commission has reviewed, and will continue to review all compliance complaints as expeditiously as possible, taking appropriate enforcement action when warranted.
