## STATEMENT OF FCC COMMISSIONER AJIT PAI

I am pleased that the U.S. House of Representatives this afternoon unanimously passed a resolution calling for the preservation of the multi-stakeholder, non-governmental model of Internet governance that has served us so well. This is the latest evidence that all American policymakers stand together on a bipartisan basis to oppose international regulation of the Internet. I look forward to reviewing the initial position papers that will be filed tomorrow by Ambassador Terry Kramer with the International Telecommunications Union addressing this important issue.
